Pytanie zależne: szyk oznajmujący i cofnięcie czasu.
  4. The lifeguard warned us not to swim there.  
Warn somebody not to do. „Here” -> „there”.
  5. Marek admitted losing the keys.  
Admit + -ing.
  6. My dad advised me to take the job.  
Radę relacjonujemy przez „advise somebody to do”.
  7. My brother denied eating the last biscuit.  
Deny + -ing.
  8. Ewa accused Adam of copying her homework.  
Accuse somebody of doing something.
  9. Kasia suggested taking the train.  
Suggest + -ing (nie: suggest somebody to do).
  10. Grandma insisted on us staying for dinner.  
Insist on + (somebody) + -ing.
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
